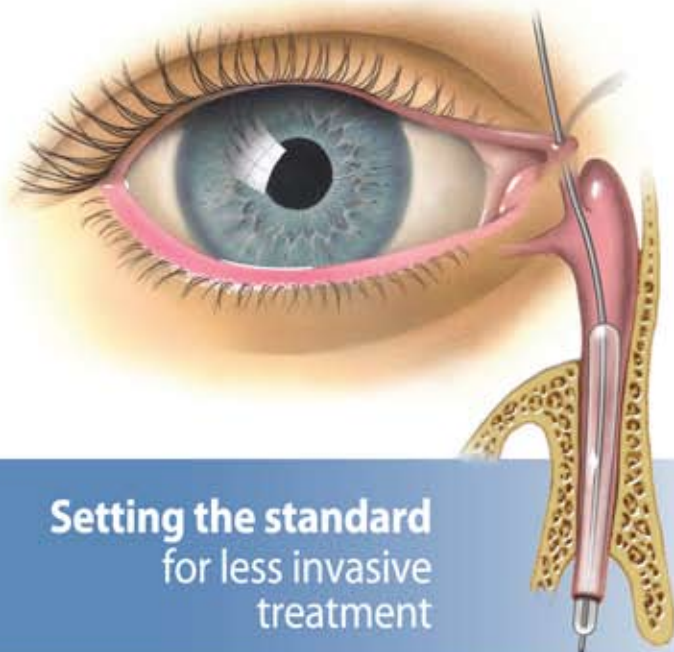

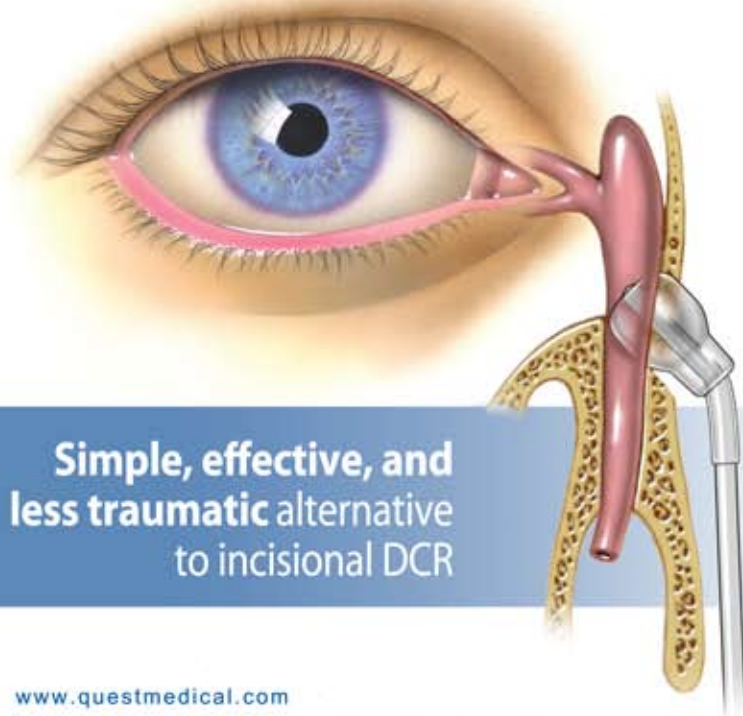

Dacryoplasty (DCP)

- Achieves dilation of the lacrimal duct in up to 95% of pediatric patients*
- Provides adult patients an alternative to incisional DCR
- Reduces operative time — eliminates placement of tubes
- Less invasive, less traumatic option for your patients

- Reduced operating time
- Simple maneuvering through the nose and into the lacrimal sac
- Creation of large, round 9mm osteotomy
- Elimination of external patient scarring
- Minimally invasive approach to DCR
